ACCADEMIA CHIGIANA IN A NUTSHELL

Founded in 1932 by Count Guido Chigi Saracini, the Accademia Musicale Chigiana is a world-renowned institution for advanced musical studies. Housed in a historic palazzo with more than one hundred rooms and an exquisite art collection, the Chigiana hosts masterclasses, seminars, and a prestigious summer music festival. Distinguished alumni include Daniel Barenboim, Claudio Abbado, Esa-Pekka Salonen, Maurizio Pollini, and Salvatore Accardo, among others.

THE 4-WEEK MUSIC PROGRAM

A distinctive, intensive STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM with 3 weeks in person in Siena.

Students will refine their artistic skills through pre-professional experiences both in the classroom and by performing in historic venues across Siena and Tuscany. Participants will also take part in the PRIMAVERA CHIGIANA FESTIVAL, which runs during the program.

SUMMER 2026 COURSES

PERFORMANCE STUDIES – VOICE

The course includes two weekly private voice lessons, coaching, and masterclasses led by renowned international faculty and guest artists. Concert performances in Siena and across Tuscany offer a transformative, immersive experience for young, aspiring musicians.

MUSIC HISTORY

Focus: Italian Belcanto – an in-depth exploration of its style, history, and influence. Enriched with cultural visits to Siena, Florence, and Venice for a deeper understanding of Italy's musical heritage.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE & DICTION

A dynamic Italian language course tailored for musicians, from beginners to advanced students, with a strong emphasis on diction and pronunciation.

CULTURAL TRIPS

Experience the artistic and historical treasures of Siena, Florence, and Venice through guided excursions.
